If you are a hearing person and you want to call individuals who are Deaf, Hard of Hearing, DeafBlind or those with a Speech Disability, all you have to do is dial **711**. It is that easy! (If the phone from which you are calling does not accept **711**, just call **800–982–8772** for the same great results).

## Follow these simple steps:

- 1. Dial 711 (or 800-982-8772).
- 2. A specially trained West Virginia relay operator will answer and identify themselves by their operator number.
- 3. Give the relay operator the phone number of the person you are calling.
- 4. The relay operator will connect you with the person you are calling and will assist you with communication.

## It really is that easy!

Remember, calls can be made to anywhere in the world, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. All calls are strictly confidential and no records of any conversation are maintained.
