RCC is a no-cost service for West Virginians with hearing loss or speech disabilities, allowing them to join conference calls or webinars via a laptop or mobile device with high-speed Internet.

How RCC works:

1. Captioners connect via a conference bridge.
2. The captioner listens and captions via the conference bridge what is heard in real time.
3. RCC participants read captions via an Internet connection.

Conference calls:

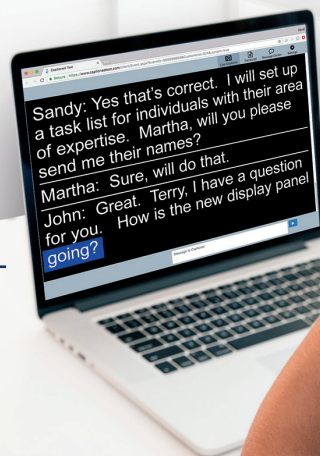
RCC participants receive captions through an Internet browser on a computer or mobile device.
